### **Review of Previous Meeting Notes**

- Minutes were handed out and read individually. Nominated for approval by Pat. Seconded by Kevin.

### **Official Business**

- Discussed model storm water runoff law
  - We will recommend to the town board that they adopt the stricter variation of the law.
- Discuss the Phillipsburgh concrete and asphalt plant project
  - We formally requested to the planning board that the public hearing be left open for 30 days. The board closed the public hearing, but left open the period for written comments for an additional 30 days.
  - Sal attended the public hearing and spoke before the board. He also took notes of others comments and passed them out for review.
  - Reviewed the maps, pictures and plans.
    - In general, the plans are very detailed and appear to show concern for the plants impact upon the environment and the cemetery
  - Divided DEIS between the attending members for review:
    - Pat – cultural resources and particularly the cemetery
    - Mike – air quality
    - Kevin – soil and water
    - Sal – traffic impact, land use and zoning, noise
