**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF WALLKILL
CONFIRMING ABANDONMENT OF HIGHWAY, DIRECTING ENTRY OF
CERTIFICATE OF ABANDONMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE GRANT OF
RIGHT OF WAY AND SALE OF PROPERTY CONSTITUTING GILLEN ROAD**

WHEREAS, a road known as Gillen Road is shown on subdivision map #3; and

WHEREAS, Section 205(1) of the New York State Highway Law provides that if a public street is not opened or worked within six (6) years after dedication to the public or if a public street has not been traveled or used as a street for a period of six (6) years, then such highway shall cease to be a public street and the Town Board shall direct the Highway Superintendent to declare the street abandoned; and

WHEREAS, a street is legally abandoned upon the expiration of the six-year period of non-use specified above; and

WHEREAS, the dimensions and acreage of Gillen Road are as described in the attached Description of Lands to Be Conveyed to ESPM dated July 2007 and as depicted on the certified survey dated November 20, 2006, by Daniel P. Yanosh entitled A2 Lot Subdivision Phase 2 Lands of ESPM LLC. Shawangunk Road, Weld Road and Gillen Road Town of Wallkill County of Orange, State of New York and annexed hereto as Schedule A;

WHEREAS, the dimensions and acreage of Gillen Road as described in Schedule A has not been traveled or used as a public street for a period of six (6) years as indicated in the Memorandum of the Town Superintendent of Highways, John Lippert, dated August 22, 2007, and annexed hereto as Schedule B; and

WHEREAS, the adjoining landowners and those having an interest in the real property constituting the dimensions and acreage of Gillen Road as described in Schedule A have been notified of the towns intention to abandon that portion of Gillen Road and have not objected thereto; and

WHEREAS, to protect the existing rights it has in the property constituting the portion of Gillen Road that is being abandoned, Orange & Rockland Utilities, Inc. has sought the execution of a Grant of Right of Way agreement for a centerline fifteen foot (15') wide utility easement from the Town of Wallkill and ESPM, LLC, as described in the attached Grant of Right of Way and Description Centerline 15' Wide Orange and Rockland Utility Easement Gillen Road and annexed hereto as Schedule C; and

WHEREAS, the dimensions and acreage of Gillen Road as described in Schedule A is not needed by the Town, there is no other Town purpose for such property, and such property is useless and surplus; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Wallkill has determined that the proposed sale of the dimensions and acreage of Gillen Road as described in Schedule A will not have a significant adverse affect on the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Wallkill that:

1. The dimensions and acreage of Gillen Road as described in Schedule A has ceased to be a Town highway as a matter of fact and law and its abandonment as a Town highway is hereby confirmed; and
2. The Town Superintendent of Highways is hereby directed to file in the Town Clerk's office a Certificate of Abandonment, with a copy of the documents that
3. are annexed hereto as Schedule A, formally abandoning the dimensions and acreage of Gillen Road as described in Schedule A as a Town Road; and
4. The Town Supervisor is hereby authorized to execute the Grant of Right of Way in favor of Orange & Rockland Utilities, Inc.; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Wallkill hereby declares the dimensions and acreage of Gillen Road as described in Schedule A as surplus property; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Wallkill hereby approves the sale of the abandoned portion of Gillen Road described in Schedule A, annexed hereto, pursuant to New York State Town Law 64 (2) and subject to a permissive referendum.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Wallkill hereby authorizes the Town Supervisor to execute the necessary documents to convey by quit claim deed the dimensions and acreage of Gillen Road as described in Schedule A to ESPM, LLC, for the price of \$3,500.00 as fair and adequate consideration

WHEREAS, the Town Board is researching alternate measures to save the Town from having to make such a contribution, including the establishment of a transportation

district and/or a traffic mitigation or improvement district; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Wallkill needs to prepare a map, plan and report of the proposed district area, in order to evaluate its options and/or implement one

of the aforementioned districts;

WHEREAS, an infiltration and inflow remediation project has been undertaken in the Silver Lake/Scotchtown area of the Town, and

WHEREAS, additional infiltration and inflow remediation work would be appropriate in that area to further relieve existing sanitary sewer conditions during significant storms and to make the remediation project more effective, and

WHEREAS, the work would consist of installing approximately 900 feet of sewer pipe through pipe bursting methods from the existing manhole at Silverlake Scotchtown Road and Freezer Road to the existing manhole at Silverlake Scotchtown Road and Janice Drive through and under the existing Town right of way, and

WHEREAS, Metra Industries, the contractor hired for the infiltration and inflow remediation project, has submitted a price of \$209,000.00 to perform the work as Change Order #4 to the existing contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF WALLKILL that the Town Board agrees to Change Order #4 to the existing contract with Metra Industries for the infiltration and inflow remediation project so that

Metra Industries can install approximately 900 feet of sewer pipe through pipe bursting methods from the existing manhole at Silverlake Scotchtown Road and Freezer Road to the existing manhole at Silverlake Scotchtown Road and Janice Drive through and under the existing Town right of way at a total cost of \$209,000.00.

Mr. Valentin: Questions as to how this was missed by the first review, feels that this dollar amount is more than a change order.

Supervisor Ward explains that a change order doesn't refer to the dollar amount.

Mr. Mulqueen: The opinion of our attorney is different than several weeks ago, does not have to much confidence in this opinion.

Mr. Smith: The amount of the change order is less than ten percent of the total of the project.. The change orders on the Town Hall project were probably more. this project was set up with 13 mini areas of meters, based on t.v. inspection they determined what needed replacement. The Freezer Rd manhole no longer overflowed, but the next manhole did. Mr. Valentin says we agree to disagree.

Mr. Smith: Lets assume you are correct , what does the Town gain by hiring a new engineer to do this. It will be very costly .

Mr. King: Beside the money concern the sewer line is not working correctly, and this needs to be repaired.
